

Dear Friend,

Following the cancellation of the African Children's Choir concert due to take place at The King's Centre on 28 November 2009, we are pleased to announce that this concert will now take place in the summer of 2010 when the choir returns to the UK. We won't know the actual date until February when we will of course let you know.

In this situation we can offer you 4 options...

1. **Keep your tickets.** Simply retain your tickets and they will be valid for the new concert.
2. **Donate.** As the children's charity 'Music for Life' will be missing out on the offering, sponsorship and merchandising opportunities that the concert would have given them, some people are choosing to donate the value of their tickets to the Music for Life charity and will opt to buy new tickets when the concert is rescheduled.

3. **Obtain a refund.** You may simply want a refund. That is fine. This will be done immediately although please note that if you purchased your tickets through the Good Book Company, the booking fee is not refundable.
4. **Wait & see.** You may want to hold onto your tickets for the new date but find, when the actual date is announced, that you cannot make that date. At that stage options 2 and 3 above would still be available. Please let us know what you would like to do at that time.

**What to do next.**

- If you would like to retain your tickets for the rescheduled concert - then simply do nothing. If we don't hear from you we will assume that is what you are doing.
